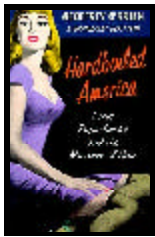

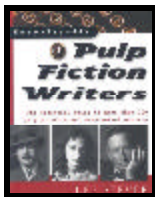
Now available at the Library of Pulp - three excellent new reference books filled with information about influential pulp fiction writers.
